The GCDA is a chapter of the Society of Decorative Painters. We were chartered in 1980 as the Queen City Tolars. As the chapter grew, our name changed to reflect the geographic areas of the Tri-State, which included Southwest Ohio, Cincinnati, Northern Kentucky, and Eastern Indiana.

GCDA Mission

We are an organization that promotes painting. Classes are offered in acrylics, oils, watercolors, pen & ink, colored pencils, plus enhancing your painting skills and techniques. The Greater Cincinnati Decorative Artists is a support group for people to share their creativity with fellow members and help serve the community.



Painting Retreat

Each spring our Chapter holds a weekend painting retreat. A variety of painting classes are offered by experienced teachers in all painting media. Everyone is encouraged to participate in classes that will expand their skills, build confidence, make new friends, and renew old friendships. It is a wonderful weekend experience of painting and fun. The Retreat is offered to members and nonmembers.

GCDA holds 11 meetings a year on the second Sunday of the month, except May and December.

The May meeting is adjusted to recognize Mother's Day. The Chapter dispenses the regular business meeting in December for our Holiday Party.

The regular business meeting begins at Noon and is followed by a 2 - 3 hour painting class taught by one of our many talented local teachers. The class varies each month.

Painting projects include acrylics, oils, watercolors, colored pencils, graphite, and fabric paints. Project items may include wood, glass, canvas, clothing, silk, tin, or watercolor paper.

We hold one day (6 hour) Seminars/Workshops several times a year and all are encouraged to attend.

We have a Monthly Newsletter, Palette Chatter, that lets everyone in the Chapter know what is happening within the Chapter (if they happen to miss a meeting), painting projects for the next month, Seminars/Workshops projects that are coming up, Community Art Events, and news on our Members.

Chapter Information

Our Chapter is governed by our Charter and By-Laws. We operate under the guidance of a volunteer Chapter Board. Offices are President, 1st Vice President Programs, 2nd Vice President Membership, Secretary and Treasurer, plus many Committees that handle Hospitality, Painting Retreat, Publicity, Website, Historian, Sunshine, and a Service Project each year.
